Buffalo, New York's Last Conservative make their Good Charamel Records debut with *On To The Next One*, a collection of hard-hitting rock songs all set to catchy melodies and irresistible beats. Since Last Conservative's formation in the mid-1990s, singer-songwriter/vocalist and guitarist T.J. Zindle has remained the sole constant in the group's ever-evolving sound. Over the years, another constant in Last Conservative's rise to success has been the superb quality of song craft and high-energy live performances.

Last Conservative's recent recordings exhibit a writing style that is simultaneously self-aware and given to moments of abandon within the space of the same song. Having settled on a line-up featuring bassist Josh Mullin, guitarist David Julian and drummer Tom McCluskey, Last Conservative is now ready to take the airwaves by storm. Recently the group charted not one song but two songs; *On To The Next One* and *Fourfive*, on XM Radio's Channel 52 Unsigned for week ending July 22. Last Conservative was even placed on the ballot for, "Best Unsigned Artist," for the 2005 XM Nation Awards.

A steady stream of nationwide tours, opening slots for the likes of Jimmy Eat World and Goo Goo Dolls just to name a few, and this upcoming release, the first full-length CD to be released by a band on Goo Goo Doll Robby Takac's Good Charamel Records, will undoubtedly give Last Conservative the wider exposure it so richly deserves.
